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Hole is best 3 times as wide as the width of the root ball. Imperative that it is a WIDE hole **NOT** a narrow post hole **Must NOT BE**

PREPARING THE HOLE

The hole is best 3 times as wide as the width of the plant's root ball but not very deep. Basically not a narrow post hole shape but a WIDE square hole. This way, the roots go laterally and not round in a tight ball.

FERTILISER

We simply use and recommend a general purpose Osmocote for all plants EXCEPT FOR GREVILLEA. For Grevillea, we recommend "RICHGRO" "NATIVE" brand from Bunnings with NO phosphorous.

HOW TO APPLY FERTILISER

Once you have dug the hole and placed the root ball in the hole, it is best to put half of the soil back in the hole, sprinkle the fertiliser around the root ball (halfway up the root ball), then complete the backfilling of the hole.

AMOUNT OF FERTILISER TO USE

140mm pots - 6 teaspoons of Osmocote

200mm pots - 8 teaspoons of Osmocote

250mm pots - 10 teaspoons of Osmocote

300mm pots - 12 teaspoons of Osmocote

45 litre bags - 4 "closed" fistfuls of Osmocote (4 fistfuls on 4 levels is recommended)

100 litre bags - 5 "closed" fistfuls of Osmocote (5 fistfuls on 5 levels is recommended)
